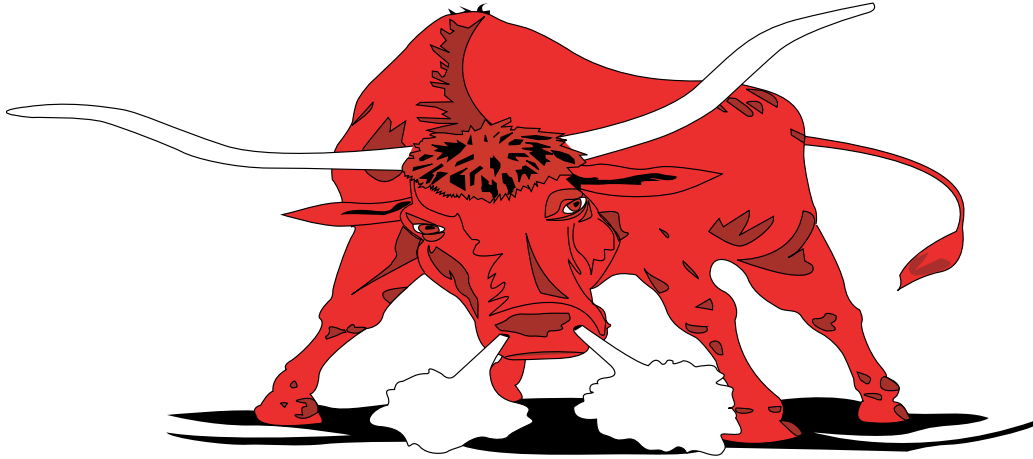
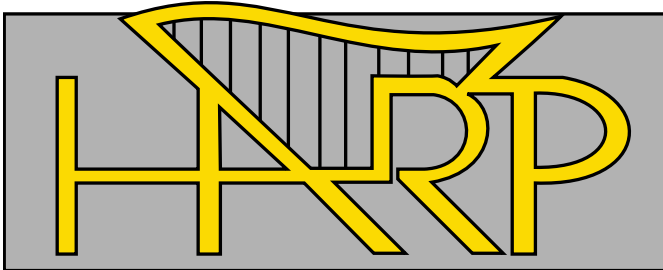

Round 7 Wrap

A more successful round for the Bulls with the 1sts winning a thrilling outright against 08/09 MacGibbon Shield premiers STC; The 2nds making 312 and winning easy against Hawthorn; The 3rds fighting back from an early batting collapse to beat North Balwyn Combined; The 4ths being led by Lukey Paolini bowling out STC and The 6ths smashing Wyclif.

Congratulations to our centurions Darren Read (117) and Phil Quirk (139). Both knocks were also part of extremely good partnerships and set up the wins for each team. Also congratulations to Shaun Senerath Bandara who took 6/42

The final round before Xmas is a must win game for teams to consolidate positions in the final four as well as for those outside to close the gap. A couple of wins has seen the 4ths and 6ths climb to one game out of the top four whilst the 3rds need a win to stay in touch. With the 7ths 3 games out and 6 games left, a few wins could start to really mould the finals make up.

The Firsts... The first Saturday saw STC skittled for 132 with Trent Linford doing most of the damage with 4/24. The Bulls went out to bat and at the end of the day were 5/135 with 6 points in the bag. Day 2 saw the Bulls take the score along to 202 with Nifty top scoring with 46. STC going into bat again were in big trouble and could only post 114. This time Micky P did the damage with the ball taking 4/42 which left the bulls 46 off 10 overs to win outright. 4.5 overs was all that was needed with Doss making 42 not out and dispatching all bowlers with his straight driving down the ground text book imagery (the jungle drums beat for a 20/20 position). Absolutely fantastic game by the 1st XI.

The Seconds... Losing the toss, the 2nds were sent into bat. At 1/3, the decision was vindicated until a 161 run second wicket partnership between Bonno Ellis and Dasha Read took the score to 2/167 after 65 overs. Dasha and Cully continued to push the scoring along and at 4/211 at the 72nd over, a 80 run partnership between Hillisy and Wally and 17 off 2 overs by Imesha saw the team reach 7/310 (including 54 extras). Dasha scoring a chanceless 117 while Bonno scored 39 off 65 overs which laid the foundations for the team's batting success.

Coming into bowl with 300+, the 2nds got off to a good start with Vikram taking the 1st wicket at 13. A second wicket partnership of 50 saw Hawthorn in with a chance but the loss of consistent wickets and tight bowling throughout the innings saw Hawthorn finally succumb to be all out for 190. Best of the bowlers was Banders with 6/42 and Snoop Dog Perera with 3/57 off 20 overs.

The Thirds... Playing North Balwyn Combined, the 3rds batted first and were in trouble at 7/118. A magnificent 157 run partnership between Captain Quirky (139) and Paul Harman (62) followed by a last wicket partnership of 41 between Penguin McRae and Richura Silva saw a very competitive 326 runs set to defend. Day two saw the Bulls come out swinging and after 42 overs, NBC were bowled out for 125. Paul Harman with his second Michelle Pfeiffer (5/46) and Macca 4/13 off 6 overs broke the game apart. Sent in again, the second innings of NBC saw them dig in and the game was called off at 3/110.

The Fourths... Playing STC on the postage stamp known as Nettleton Park, the 4ths got off to a good start at 2/76 but struggled along to be 7/126 before a solid 46 run partnership between Daisy and Rosie took the score 8/172. A 30 run cameo by Larko saw the 4ths set a defendable 224. Confidant in knocking over STC, Lukey Paolini (5/33) and Rosie (3/35) broke STC's back to have them all out for 153 and a great win by the 4ths.

The Fifths... Clifton Hill batted first and some consistent partnerships saw them post a competitive score on Coopers of 222. Andrew Whitwell was the pick of the bowlers with another four wickets. On Day 2 the top order crumbled before Matt Sanders and Addsy Nicholls took the score along to 4/124 with a century partnership. Although back on track the loss of 6 wickets for 31 put paid to the Bulls chances.

The Sixths... winning the toss, Wyclif elected to bat and after a slow 56 overs, were bowled out for 100. Matt Posar (3/26) and Rohan "After 20 years I have finally found my home in the 6ths" Phillips (3/10) did the damage with the ball. Rob Leisham (69) bolstered the Bulls innings and was last man out when the Bulls past the Wyclif total 5 down.

The Sevenths... Batting first against the Deepdene Bears, the 7ths were travelling nicely to be 4/112 before the Burwood collapse kicked in and were bowled out for 143. The Bears piled on the runs and declared at 3/316 before the Bulls went in and faced 25 overs and at 3/65 the game was called off. I am not sure why a team would make such a huge total and not give yourself time to bowl the team out...but, the outright was diverted, so well done 7ths.
